

## Ribbon in the Sky with Amanda Maccavour



### YOUR KIT FEE PROVIDES:

- Embroidery Floss: For hand stitching.
- Hand Sewing Needles: Also for hand stitching.
- Thread: Polyester machine embroidery threads. Sulky® Water-soluble Stabilizer (Solvly): Each person will get 1 yard Sulky® Sticky Fabri Solvy and 1 yard Sulky® Solvy to make their ribbon scarf as a part of the class project. Small samples of a variety of stabilizers will be provided for quick samples.

### MATERIALS NEEDED:

#### Ribbons:

- 3 different ribbons will be the base of your project. Bring in 4 yards of each type. Ribbons can be thick or thin and can be any colour/material you would like.

### OPTIONAL MATERIALS, but recommended:

- Scrap fabrics : Bring materials that you love. I know I have bins of beautiful fabric I'm just saving- and you might too! Bring some of your beauties to integrate into your project.
- Scrap yarns : Do you have scraps from previous projects that you are saving? This technique is an excellent way to recycle some of these materials.
- Sewing threads : These will be used for stitching your piece together. Bring in some threads that will fit with your colour scheme but also bring in some unexpected colours.
- Roving : This looks excellent with machine embroidery.
- Extras : Anything that you would like to include like buttons, sequins, lace, trim, thin wire etc. are welcome.
